

Riders are responsible for acting in a respectable and orderly manner, for the efficient supervision and safety of the Arenas in use, for the proper conduct of persons under their control and generally for preserving the good reputation of Dudgeley Farm.

Control

Riders are responsible for ensuring that their horses/ponies are at all times under control and not a danger to themselves or third parties.

Damage

Riders are to take good care of and not cause any damage to the Arenas or to any fittings, equipment or other property in the Arenas and are to make good and pay for any such damage caused by any act or neglect of the Rider or of anyone for whom the Rider is responsible or anyone permitted by the Rider to attend the Arenas.

Insurance

Riders must have in force a policy of insurance effected with a reputable insurance company covering the Rider against third party risks.

Liability and Indemnity

Dudgeley Farm will not be liable for the death of or injury to or loss to any person or horse or any losses, claims, demands, actions, proceedings, damages, costs or expenses or other liability arising out of any breach of these Conditions and/or incurred by or due to the activities of or supervised by the Rider, except where such death, injury or loss is due to the negligence of Dudgeley Farm owners or staff or otherwise imposed by statute, and the Rider will indemnify Dudgeley Farm and its owners and staff against all such liabilities.

Personal Property

Dudgeley Farm will not under any circumstances accept responsibility or liability in respect of any damage to or loss of goods, articles or property of any kind brought into or left at the Arenas.

Rules

- dogs are not permitted at the Arenas**
- no consumption of alcohol either at or prior to attending the Arenas**
- all riders to wear a riding helmet and boots conforming to BSI/ISO standards**
- arena gates to remain closed for all riding activities**
- gates not to be operated while mounted**
- all dung to be picked up immediately and placed in trailer provided**

Arenas - Conditions of Use

Dudgeley Farm wish everyone to be able to enjoy their horses in a quiet, friendly and safe environment and therefore require that everyone abides by these conditions (which include any others given by its staff at any time) in order to achieve this. Breach of these conditions may lead to immediate and permanent expulsion and no express or implied waiver will prohibit future enforcement.

We aim to maintain the arenas in good and safe condition but you must notify us immediately and stop using them as soon as you become aware of any damage, defect or lack of repair.

Please note that the arenas are NOT supervised. Riders use them at their own risk.

The yard office is located by the house and will be manned part-time. If you have an issue when a member of Dudgeley Farm staff can not be found around the Yard, please contact Roon 07969849786.

Access

Parking and arena access is on the opposite side of the farm approximately 100 yards on.

Unauthorised access or failure to comply with these conditions will disqualify from further bookings.

Accidents

All accidents must be recorded on an "Accident Form". Forms are located in the office. Please record all details in full.

Vaccinations

All horses to have received their latest booster within the last 12 months and have a compliant vaccination history. Passports will be checked for compliance. We strongly recommend if the horse is attending events that they have a booster if their last vaccination was more than six months ago.

Arenas

Arenas to be used responsibly and only for horse exercise and training within the knowledge and capability of horse and rider.

Children

Children under 12 years must be supervised personally by the Rider at all times - and see 'Supervision' below.
